

BYLAWS OF YHS THEATRE ARTS PARENTS (excerpt)

Article I Name and Purpose

1.01. Name. The name of this organization shall be YHS Theatre Arts Parents.

1.02. Purpose. The organization is organized and operated for the charitable and educational purposes of supporting Yorktown High School's Theatre Arts Program.

Article II Membership

2.01. Qualification. All parents, guardians or other persons with a child currently or previously participating in the Yorktown High School Theatre Arts Program, community members, and other individuals as approved by the membership shall be considered voting members of the organization.

2.02. Rights and responsibilities. The members shall have the right and responsibility to attend meetings and events sponsored by the organization, serve on committees and be nominated and elected to office. Voting members shall have the right to vote for the officers, review and approve the annual budget and approve amendments to these bylaws.

Article III Board of Directors

3.01. Membership. The Board of Directors shall consist of the elected officers of the organization.

Article IV Officers and Their Elections Section

4.01. Officers. The officers of this organization shall include one President, two Vice Presidents, a Secretary and a Treasurer and, as a non-voting member, an At-Large Director. Additional officer(s) may be elected or appointed by the Board of Directors from time to time.

4.02. Election. Officers shall be elected at the annual meeting of the organization by the members present. Officers shall assume their official duties upon election.
